1. **William PENINGTON**¹ was born in Henham, Essex.¹ He died in 1592 in London.¹ He was buried in 1592 in St Benet Gracechurch, London.¹ At some point he married **Alice**.

Alice² died in 1607.² She was buried on 9 October 1607 in St Benet Gracechurch.² She and William PENINGTON had the following children:

2. **Robert PENINGTON**,¹ son of William PENINGTON and Alice, was born in 1550.¹ He was a Fishmonger.¹ He died in 1627.¹ At some point he married **Judith SHETTERDEN**.

Judith SHETTERDEN,¹ daughter of Isaac SHETTERDEN of London (-), was born in 1559.¹ She died in 1622.¹ She and Robert PENINGTON had the following children:

3. **Isaac PENINGTON**,³ son of Robert PENINGTON and Judith SHETTERDEN, was born in 1584 in London.^{1,3} He had the title 'Sir'. He was a Fishmonger, Cloth Trader, MP for City of London, Lord Mayor.^{1,3} He was admitted to the Fishmongers Guild in 1613.¹ He married **Abigail ALLEN** on 7 February 1615 in Hackney, London.¹ He married **Mary YOUNG** on 5 December 1629. He died on 16 December 1661 in Tower of London.^{1,3}

Fourth Generation

4. **Isaac PENINGTON**,^{4,5} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, was born in 1616 in London.^{1,3} He was resident in The Grange, Chalfont St Peter, Bucks.⁴ He was a Quaker Minister & Writer.^{1,6} He was admitted to the Inner Temple in November 1634.¹ He matriculated from St Catherines College, Cambridge on 1 April 1637.¹ He was imprisoned in Aylesbury Jail for attending a quaker funeral in March 1665. On 8 October 1679 he was resident in Amersham Woodside, Bucks.⁶ He was a Quaker. He died on 8 October 1679 in Goodnestone Court, Kent.^{1,2,3,6} He was buried in Jordans, Chalfont St Giles, Bucks.^{5,6,7} At some point he married **Mary PROUDE**.

Mary PROUDE,^{5,8} daughter of John PROUDE (-1628) and Anne FAGGE (-1628), was born in Goodnestone Court.¹ She was baptised on 13 December 1623 in Canterbury, Kent.¹ She was a Quaker & Writer.¹ Her will was written on 18

July 1680. On 18 September 1682 she was resident in Amersham Woodside.⁶ She was a Quaker. She died on 18 September 1682 in Worminghurst, Sussex.^{2,6} Her will was proved in October 1682. She was buried in 1682 in Jordans.^{1,6,7} She and Isaac PENINGTON had the following children:

5. **William PENINGTON**,⁹ son of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, was a Merchant of London & Quaker.^{2,9} His will was written on 4 January 1688. His will was proved in April 1689.
6. At some point **Abigail PENINGTON**,⁹ daughter of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, married **CORBET**.
7. At some point **Bridget PENINGTON**,⁹ daughter of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, married **MOORE**.
8. At some point **Judith PENINGTON**,⁹ daughter of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, married **MOLINEUX**.
9. **Arthur PENINGTON**,^{1,2} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN, was a Catholic Priest.^{1,2} He was a Catholic.
10. **Daniel PENINGTON**^{1,2} was the son of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN.
11. **Ann PENINGTON**² was the daughter of Isaac PENINGTON and Abigail ALLEN.

Fifth Generation

12. **John PENINGTON , Gent**,^{1,5,7,9} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Mary PROUDE, was born in 1655 in Jordans, Chalfont St Giles, Bucks.¹ He inherited his mothers houses and lands at Amersham Woodside and in Kent in October 1682.⁵ On 31 May 1708 he was resident in Amersham Woodside, Bucks.⁷ His will was written on 31 May 1708. His will was proved on 2 June 1710. He was a Quaker Apologist.¹ He died in 1710.^{1,7} He was buried in Jordans.⁷
13. **Isaac PENINGTON**,^{1,10} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Mary PROUDE, was born "abt 1656".¹ He died in 1669 in at sea.^{2,10}
14. **Mary PENNINGTON**,^{7,8,9,11} daughter of Isaac PENINGTON and Mary PROUDE, was born on 10 February 1657 in Chalfont St Peter, Bucks.^{1,12} She was a Quaker.¹² She inherited £30 per annum while she remains unmarried and then £300 upon her marriage from her mother in October 1682.⁵ On 4 September 1686 she was resident in Amersham, Bucks.¹² She married **Daniel WHARLEY , Gent** on 4 September 1686 in Jordans.¹² She inherited £100 from her uncle William Pennington in April 1689.⁹ She inherited 1 guinea from her friend Thomas Ellwood on 15 May 1713.¹³ In 1726 she was resident in Aylesbury, Bucks.¹⁴ She was a Quaker. She died on 13 September 1726.¹² She was buried on 21 November 1726 in Jordans.^{12,15} Her will was proved on 12 January 1727.

Daniel WHARLEY , Gent,^{9,16,17} son of Henry WHARLEY (bap.1618) and Ann (-), was born on 15 July 1652 in Hunsdon, Herts.^{12,18} He was a Woolen Draper, Glover, Quaker.^{9,12,16,19,20,21} He died on 3 April 1721 in New House, Chalfont St Giles, Bucks.²² His will was proved on 18 January 1722.²³
15. **William PENINGTON**,^{5,9} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Mary PROUDE, was born on 3 August 1665.^{2,5} He inherited £500 from his mother in October 1682.⁵ He was a Merchant.² He died on 5 May 1703.^{2,5}
16. **Edward PENINGTON**,^{1,5,9} son of Isaac PENINGTON and Mary PROUDE, was born on 3 September 1667 in Amersham.^{1,2} He inherited £500 from his mother in October 1682.⁵ He was a Surveyor General of Pennsylvania, Quaker.^{1,10} He was a Quaker. He married **Sarah JENNINGS** in 1695.¹⁰ He died on 11 November 1701 in Philadelphia, USA.^{1,2}

Sarah JENNINGS^{2,10} and Edward PENINGTON had the following children:

17. **Isaac PENINGTON**,⁷ son of Edward PENINGTON and Sarah JENNINGS, was resident in Westnew Jersey, USA.⁷ He died after 1710.⁷
