
Chesham Bois Heritage Trail Louise Jopling 1848–1933

Louise Jopling, professional painter, writer, and suffragette lived in Chesham Bois at the end of her life and is buried in Chesham Bois Cemetery. A central figure in London's artistic and literary circles, she moved to Manor Farm (*now Manor House*) Chesham Bois in 1919 with her third husband George William Rowe.



She converted the adjacent barn (now Manor Barn) to a studio, founded and was President of the Chiltern Club for Arts and Handicrafts and published her memoirs **"Twenty Years of My Life"**.
