

# Chesham Bois Heritage Trail

## Chesham Bois Common and Bricky Pond



In 1979 The Parish Council bought the Common from the last Lord of the Manor, William Garrett-Pegge. Until fairly recently it was an area of grassland and gorse. From the C16th brickmakers harvested bracken and dug out '*Bricky*' pond and the many dips around the common for clay.

The Pond was re-lined and replanted in 1995. The project was delayed by the discovery of a WWII hand grenade, which was made safe by bomb disposal experts.
