

Cricket has been played on the Common for nearly 200 years and the first recorded match was on 26th July 1836.

Before the formation of the Club the Common was used for many other games of cricket between various Chesham Town teams such as the Charity Lodge of Odd Fellows, the Bootmakers and Woodenware sides!

From the early 1900's Chesham Bois CC played in the Chesham and District League, winning it on a number of occasions. Only the World Wars stopped the club playing. In 1997 a decision was taken by the club to once again enter into league cricket.
