Rene Ross turned Kensworth, a large Victorian house with a lovely garden, into a hotel after the Second World War.



The Ken House Hotel as it was known was then sold to the Uptons who built a bungalow for themselves inside the new entrance gate in Long Park. Part of the garden was sold to build eight

bungalows in Long Park
Close. The hotel was also sold
but it closed down. After
being left empty for many
years, it was vandalised and
burnt down in 1987. It was
finally demolished in 1989
and replaced by Laurel Court.
