
Chesham Bois Heritage Trail Manor House



The development of Chesham Bois village began with the 1896 auction of the Manor Estate. With the prospect of the railway coming to the area, John Hailey Morten had bought Manor Farm in 1884 and planned on making a healthy profit selling the land for building plots.

Known as Manor House today it was never the manor house for Chesham Bois, but was one of four farms that supplied provisions for the Manor (demolished in the early c19th) near St Leonard's. It can be found on the earliest maps dating from 1712 when it was part of the Cheyne Estate.
