Anne's Corner



This Grade II listed building was built in 1910 on land bought by Arthur Lazenby Liberty in the Manor Farm Auction of 1896. No 1 appears to have been built on the foundations of the Aris Bakers Shop and horses were probably stabled round the back as a large number of horse shoes were found in the garden of No 3. The current owner was told that a horse was kept in the house which still has a stable front door! For many years No 5 was the Post Office.

Joseph Darvell bought all of Anne's Corner in January 1944 after attending as the local Fire Officer, when the shop was damaged by a bomb during WWII.
