There have been a variety of shops in the village since the early 1900's when William Henry Aris had a Bakers Shop where Anne's Corner is today. There has been a Post Office in a variety of premises, a butchers, general stores, a sweetshop, several grocers, a dressmakers, tailors, a wool shop, a cobblers, and even an early recording studio!

Stanley Parade 1960. Were just after the terrace of Lindfield, Ingleside, Wyburn and Cowley. No 2 was the Post Office until it was re-sited at Anne's Corner
